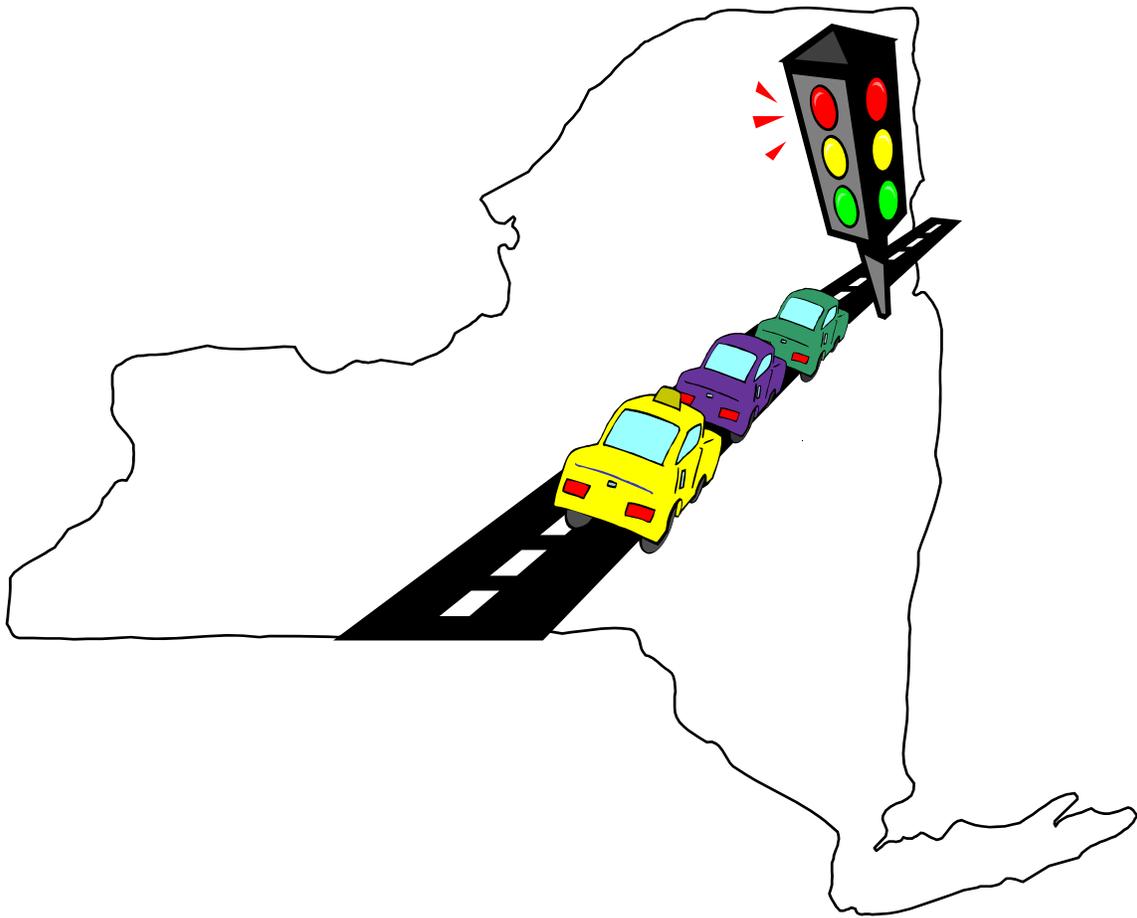

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COUNTY TRAFFIC SAFETY DATA







Suffolk County Tickets Issued by TSLED Agencies By Agency Type




Seat Belt Tickets
